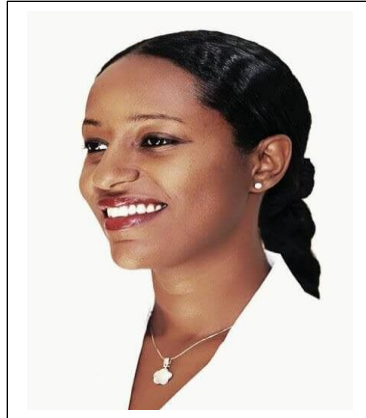


SEED Honoree, Ms. Ledet Muleta:
