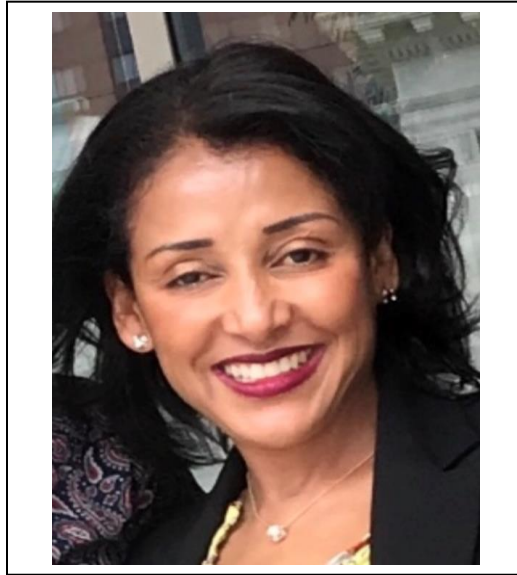


SEED honoree Prof. Senait Fisseha, MD, JD
